in Dzierżoniów on 28-30 September.

This year, Israel celebrated the 70th Independence Day and Poland celebrates the 100th anniversary of regaining independence. In the light of the common history of both countries and after 15 years of its existence and work in Dzierżoniów, the Foundation Beiteinu Chaj is proud to organize the first festival "U RUTIKI", which through culture and art, wants to celebrate strong ties between Poland and Israel. The aim of the festival is to meet artists from both countries and create opportunities to establish international contacts and cooperation.

The theme of the first edition of the festival will be "Temporary House". In 2018, we want to focus on the transitional experience, a temporary apartment, that can be experienced in the "Sukkah" hut and furthermore on the immigration of Polish and Israeli citizens in the past and today.

Chosen projects will be presented in the Rutika Synagogue. We invite artists, during the three-day festival (28 - 30 September), to get acquainted with the city, its surroundings and its inhabitants. We want to create a new tradition: the Israeli-Polish festival in Dzierżoniów.
